Medal haul for local Taekwon-Do competitors

Counties Manukau Taekwon-Do competitors have proved the region is a force to be reckoned with in nationwide competition, pulling off a big medal haul at the national champs and finishing as top team.

A 67-strong regional contingent made the trip to Levin on Queen's Birthday weekend for the Epson National Taekwon-Do Championships at Horowhenua Events Centre, where they joined a record field of 388 competitors.

The team had a rich Franklin vein, with instructors and students from Waiuku, Wai au Pa and Pukekohe either winning medals or competing well in team events towards the top-team placing.

Standout Franklin performer was Wai au Pa's Steve Morris, who shared the coveted overall National Best Black Belt award, while his clubmate Daniel Jackson was also in the medals with a gold in Patterns and silver in Special Techniques. Wai au Pa ended the tournament with nine gold, three silver and three bronze, and with four members among
